Record Breaking Financial Results



HUDCO delivered a record financial performance in FY 2025–26, reinforcing its role in advancing infrastructure development and the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047. The company achieved its highest-ever net profit of ₹4,034.37 crore, supported by record loan sanctions, disbursements and a robust loan portfolio. During the year, loan sanctions reached an all-time high of ₹1,64,757.79 crore, while loan disbursements rose to a record ₹51,194.21 crore. Revenue from operations stood at ₹13,150.40 crore and the loan book expanded to ₹1,60,724.30 crore, registering 29% growth. HUDCO also reduced its borrowing cost by 27 basis points, announced its highest-ever dividend



payout of ₹6.05 per share, and significantly lowered NPAs to 0.05%, moving closer to becoming a Zero Net NPA company. In the press meet held on the occasion, CMD Shri Sanjay Kulshrestha attributed the performance to policy reforms, resource diversification, digital transformation, ESG initiatives and improved governance. He highlighted the launch of the Urban Invest Window (UiWIN) to support Urban Challenge Fund projects and the expansion of HUDCO's PPP financing across roads, real estate, energy, airports and seaports, reaffirming the Corporation's commitment to sustainable infrastructure growth and long-term stakeholder value.

ITEC Training Programmes



HUDCO successfully organised the 61st and 62nd Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Training Programmes on "Leadership Skills for Women," sponsored by the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India. Conducted at HSMI Hostel, New Delhi, the programmes brought together 45 women professionals from Iraq and 13 partner countries, promoting leadership development, gender equity, professional growth, and cross-cultural collaboration. The valedictory



sessions were attended by Shri Srinivas Kathikithala, Secretary, MoHUA; Shri Sanjay Kulshrestha, CMD, HUDCO; Shri M. Nagaraj, Director (Corporate Planning), HUDCO and Mr. Oday Hatim Mohammed, Chargé d'Affaires, Iraq, who interacted with participants. Certificates were presented, reaffirming India's commitment to women's empowerment, international cooperation, capacity building, and nurturing future women leaders.

Vijayawada: HUDCO, in collaboration with APUFIDC and the Municipal Administration & Urban Development (MA&UD) Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh, organised a two-day Urban Challenge Fund (UCF) Capacity Building Workshop for Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in Vijayawada. Inaugurated by Dr. P. Narayana, Hon'ble Minister, MA&UD, Andhra Pradesh, the programme focused on project readiness, municipal finance, PPP models, institutional funding, municipal bonds, and sustainable urban planning. The workshop aimed to strengthen the capacities of ULB officials to prepare bankable, resilient and future-ready urban infrastructure projects aligned with UCF objectives.

Jaipur: A one-day capacity building workshop on "Project Formulation & DPR Preparation for Urban Infrastructure Projects by Enhancing Revenue Streams of ULBs" under the Urban Challenge Fund was organized in Jaipur. Held in collaboration with the Department of Local Self Government, Rajasthan, the workshop was inaugurated by Shri Jhabar Singh Kharra, Hon'ble Minister for Urban Development and Housing, Rajasthan. Attended by over 180 officials from Urban Local Bodies, the programme emphasised detailed project preparation, revenue enhancement, municipal financial sustainability, and preparation of high-quality DPRs to strengthen UCF project implementation.

Chandigarh: HUDCO, in partnership with the World Bank Group and the Public-Private Infrastructure Advisory Facility (PPIAF), organised a two-day capacity building programme on "Bankable Urban Infrastructure and Private Capital Mobilisation" in Chandigarh. The workshop was inaugurated by Shri M. Nagaraj, DCP, HUDCO, and Ms. Rosanna Nitti, Senior Urban Specialist, World Bank. Bringing together senior government officials and urban development practitioners, the programme covered municipal finance, PPP frameworks, water utility reforms, and innovative financing mechanisms to mobilise private investment for sustainable and bankable urban infrastructure development.

Dehradun: In collaboration with the Urban Development Directorate, Government of Uttarakhand, a one-day workshop was organised on "Bankable Urban Infrastructure and Mobilization of Fund under Urban Challenge Fund" in Dehradun. The programme brought together over 50 participants from 18 Urban Local Bodies and state agencies. Addressing the gathering, Shri Vinod Giri Goswami, Director, Urban Development Directorate, highlighted integrated project development, while technical sessions by HUDCO experts and specialists from Deloitte covered UiWIN, municipal finance, PPPs, innovative funding, project conceptualisation, and implementation strategies for bankable urban infrastructure.

World Urban Forum 2026



HUDCO represented India's vision of Viksit Bharat 2047 at the 13th World Urban Forum (WUF 13), showcasing the country's aspirations for sustainable, inclusive and future-ready urban development. The India Pavilion was inaugurated by Shri Kuldeep Narayan, Joint Secretary, MoHUA, in the presence of Mr. Stefan Priesner, UN Resident Coordinator, and Shri Abhay Sharma, Ambassador to Azerbaijan. Shri Sanjay Kulshrestha, CMD, Shri M. Nagaraj, DCP and other senior HUDCO officials engaged with global delegates, highlighting HUDCO's UiWIN platform as a technology-driven solution for integrated urban planning, governance, sustainable infrastructure, investment-ready municipalities and affordable housing. HUDCO

actively contributed to global knowledge exchange through high-level sessions, workshops and panel discussions on innovative housing finance, climate-resilient housing, bankable municipalities and the 5A Principles of Adequate Housing under PMAY-U 2.0. CMD highlighted HUDCO's cross-subsidisation financing model, "Profitability with Social Justice", land monetisation and innovative financing mechanisms aligned with the Urban Challenge Fund (UCF). The discussions reaffirmed HUDCO's commitment to affordable housing, resilient urbanisation and international collaboration, with UiWIN receiving appreciation as a transformative platform supporting the vision of Viksit Bharat.

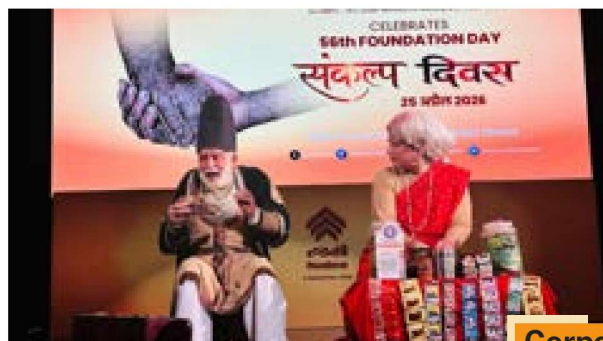


CMD Awarded for Visionary Leadership

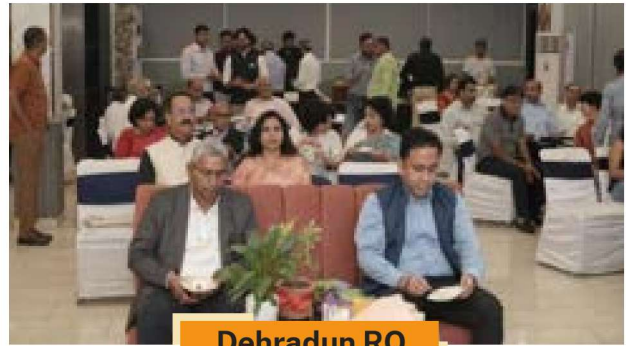
